ASSESSMENT



EVERY medical school graduate who wishes to practise in Canada will interact with the Medical Council of Canada (MCC). Through our assessment process and related services, the MCC significantly contributes to a national standard of medical care for Canadians. This includes:

- Assessing the ~12,000 medical students and graduates in Canada each year
- Evaluating international medical graduates (IMGs) in more than 500 locations around the world and in Canada

While our focus is on excellence in evaluating physicians, the MCC encompasses much more. We:

- Maintain the Canadian Medical Register, in which medical graduates are inscribed when they fulfill the MCC's requirements
- Are recognized around the world for our leadership and innovation in assessment practices
- Collaborate with many medical organizations, faculties of medicine, regulators, and individuals
- Provide physicians with an electronic portal to store credentials and easily apply for a medical licence with multiple medical regulatory authorities

MCC IS A LEADER in medical credential verification and storage. Using our physiciansapply.ca platform, candidates:

- Apply for examinations
- Submit requests for source verification and store medical credentials
- View and share examination results
- View and share medical credentials
- Easily complete applications for medical registration to Canadian medical regulatory authorities
- ...and much more

The portal also pre-populates applications and is designed to be compatible with the systems and processes of all 13 of Canada's medical regulatory bodies. It is a significant tool in the pursuit of MCC's goals and mission, helping to ensure that credential recognition for all physicians is fair, transparent, timely, and performed consistently across the country.

- MCC Blueprint project – ensuring that critical core competencies, knowledge, skills, and behaviours of physicians are appropriately assessed

Liaising with sister organizations, providing consulting, project management, and subject matter expertise are just some of the ways in which we work collaboratively to help maintain our leading edge in medical assessment and testing.

COLLABORATION



MCC IS a national and worldwide leader in psychometrics and medical testing. We often provide support and share our expertise and knowledge with a variety of groups, individuals, and the general public. This includes:

- Funded support through grants for original research and for medical educators to enhance their knowledge and skills
- Publishing technical reports on various assessment topics; producing the Deans' Reports and other special reports
- Designing new assessment and evaluation tools; developing new exams and assessments
- Liaising, presenting, publishing, and consulting in the areas of research, development, and psychometrics

In addition, the MCC promotes leadership in the industry by offering key awards and fellowships that recognize outstanding achievements, collaboration, and ongoing study in clinical assessment and evaluation, medical education, certification, psychometrics, and continuing professional competency.

In addition to physician assessment and examination, we are also a leader in verifying and storing physician credentials, which the candidate can share with medical organizations across Canada. We maintain the Canadian Medical Register, in which medical graduates are inscribed when they fulfill the MCC's requirements. Additionally, we support research and development to ensure we remain at the forefront of innovation in medical assessment.
